Artists for Global Transformation Exhibition

We invite you to participate in an art exhibition at the 2021 Conference for Global Transformation. Artists are invited to submit work for selection in any medium. Submissions will be considered by a Selection Panel of professional artists and curators who are Wisdom graduates, with selected work to be shown over the three days of the conference.

The exhibition will be based on the 2021 conference theme "Registering Accomplishment – What is possible now" and art selected will be based on its relationship to that theme. More information on the 2021 conference theme can be found in the [Call for Papers](#). Successful artists will be notified by February 14th 2021.

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

1. Artist must be a Wisdom Course Area Graduate and be the sole intellectual property owner of the submitted work.
2. Artist's submission to include:
 - a. A short statement (100 words or less) on the artist's submission and the artist's art practice,
 - b. A high-quality photo of the art,
 - c. Title of art,
 - d. Dimensions of work,
 - e. Medium used and
 - f. Date art created.
3. The closing date for submissions is midnight US Pacific time on January 15, 2021.
4. Artist must submit proposal by email to CGT.Art.Exhibition@gmail.com by the specified closing time. Email to be no more than 5Mb in size.
5. The Selection Panel will evaluate and select work for exhibition based on the following elements:
 - a. Interpretation and the clarity of the conference theme,
 - b. Creativity and originality of the artwork,
 - c. Whether the quality of the artwork meets the standard of a professional exhibition and
 - d. How the work relates to the artist's statement and the statement's relationship to the conference theme.
6. Submissions will not be considered if they contain the following material: pornography, cruelty, political or racist content.
7. Artists are responsible for round-trip shipping and insurance of artwork as well as the installation and de-installation of their work. Neither Landmark Worldwide or the Loews Hollywood Hotel is responsible for the artwork while on display at the Artists in Residence exhibition. (The exhibition will be held in a dedicated room at the Loews Hollywood Hotel for the three days of the conference and the room will be locked after core conference hours.)
8. Exhibition space: 2D artists will each have a 3m(W)x3m(H) space to exhibit and 3D artists will each have a 2m(W)x2m(L)x3m(H) space. Artists are responsible for displaying their work in a manner consistent with a professional exhibition.

9. Selected artists must label their exhibited work with the following information: artist's name, title of the art, dimensions, medium and date created.
