### Allowing Vision to Speak

Contributions could address some of the following investigations:

- Where have you, or it, slowed, stopped, or paused and created integrity where it was missing – with yourself, in your community or organization, or in your environment?
- What infrastructure did you add or upgrade? For example, did you add a reporting structure or committed listening, did you add membership, or did you upgrade your organization or linguistic environment in service of your vision and commitment? What difference did that make?
- What new resources, possibly hidden from your view, became available?
- What did you or could you stop making wrong? Did you or could you allow yourself to be empowered by what you are currently making wrong?
- Who did you or could you create yourself to be and who have you become by being willing to live a life given by your vision and commitments?
- What are you curious about now?

## Journal Papers

### Submissions close October 1, 2021

**Journal Papers** provide authors with an opportunity to articulate their research, inquiries, ideas, practices, philosophies, views, work, artistic endeavors, successes and failures on topics related to the theme of the conference as expressed in this Call for Papers. Submissions must be completed drafts of original work, no longer than 6,000 words. Papers are reviewed by an editorial committee and publication in the Journal of the Conference for Global Transformation may be subject to recommended revisions. Papers longer than 6,000 words will be returned without being reviewed by the editorial committee. You will be advised of acceptance by November 18, 2021.

**Awards.** The authors of the top papers will be invited to present at the conference; presenters are expected to attend the conference as registered participants.

**Discoveries from the Inquiries.** If you have participated in one or more of the Inquiries of the Social Commons, we invite you to submit a paper or Report from the Field. You could report on what you, or your group, have discovered, encountered or want to contribute from your inquiries. Follow the guidelines for writing a paper or submitting a Report from the Field.

## Reports from the Field

### Submissions close January 15, 2022

**A Report from the Field** is an opportunity to contribute to others by sharing about living with, and engaging in, your commitments for the world. We invite you to submit a report of up to 1,500 words about what you have discovered, accomplished or learned regarding your commitments. ## Posters

### Submissions close March 1, 2022

We invite proposals for posters that address the conference theme or any other aspect of formulating and implementing a commitment for the world. It is an opportunity to display whatever you are at work on and a great way to talk about things you have discovered, learned or accomplished, including issues you are encountering or ideas you have. Poster presenters must be registered into the 2022 conference to submit a proposal. For more information, and to submit your proposal, go to [WisdomCGT.com](http://WisdomCGT.com). ## Workshops

### Submissions close October 1, 2021

**Workshops**, typically led by one to three people, are intended to have participants investigate topics related to the theme of the conference. Successful sessions tend to include inquiry and provide access to new contexts, thinking, ideas, practices and performance regarding matters the session leaders and participants care about, are committed to, or wish to make real in the world. Workshops can also be panel presentations with three or more people giving short presentations on topics related to the theme of the conference. The presentations may be followed by questions, discussion or inquiry.

**Eligibility.** Each workshop or panel session presenter must be a Wisdom Unlimited graduate who has attended the Conference for Global Transformation as a registered participant at least once.

A collaboration of cultures, genres, styles, ideals and values is desired with no fewer than three artists. Participating artists must be registered in the 2022 conference. Videos should be between three and six minutes and all intellectual property, including images and music included in the video, should be owned by the artists.
